Chlorine Free Products Association, hereafter referred to as "CFPA" and  
**{Company Name}** hereafter referred to as "The Authorized Party"

Purpose:

WHEREAS, CFPA is engaged in certification and education services related to the use of chlorine free products;

WHEREAS, CFPA is the owner of certain trademarks, including TOTALLY and PROCESSED CHLORINE FREE and Design ("the Mark");

WHEREAS, CFPA authorizes third parties to use the Mark in connection with their paper products, subject to quality control measures detailed in the TCF/PCF Certification Standards, documents that are periodically modified by CFPA;

WHEREAS, **{Company Name}** wishes to use the Mark in connection with a qualified paper product—Rolland Enviro 100- the CFPA permits the Authorized Party to reproduce the Mark.

The Authorized Party is bound to respect to the following conditions:

### 1. Conditions

By signing this Authorization Agreement, the Authorized Party agrees:

- a) To ensure that the paper product on which the Mark is to be printed has been certified by the CFPA.
- b) To print the Mark in accordance with the CFPA guidelines
- c) To provide sample graphic applications to the CFPA upon request
- d) To pay a \$50.00, US funds, set up fee per customer to the CFPA

### 2. Liability

The Authorized Party will indemnify CFPA against any liability, losses, and costs, damages, which could arise out of this Agreement.

## USERS GUIDE FOR PCF CERTIFICATION MARK



Prior to publication, or reproduction of the CFPA TCF/PCF Certification Mark

1. The Printer, or Agency, must contact the Chlorine Free Products Association to request and sign an Authorization Agreement. {See Example page # 2}

2. The CFPA, or the manufacturer, must be able to provide a Certificate of Authenticity. We keep on file a signed affidavit by the CEO or President and Plant Manager verifying the certified manufacturers commitment to comply with the CFPA TCF/PCF Guidelines. The auditing consultant, and Executive Director of the CFPA for all products, or grades that have been certified also sign this document. A copy of this affidavit is available to anyone who requests a Certificate of Authenticity. {See page #3}

3. When printing the PCF mark either description should accompany.  
"THESE MARKS AND TERMS ARE REGISTERED TRADEMARKS OF THE CFPA."

Or

"This PCF certification mark and term are the sole property of the Chlorine Free Products Association and are only used by authorized and certified users."

4. To be printed using Pantone 3275 U for uncoated paper. To be printed using Pantone 3275 C for coated paper. May be printed Black.

## USERS GUIDE FOR TCF CERTIFICATION MARK



Prior to publication, or reproduction of the CFPA TCF/PCF Certification Mark

1. The Printer, or Agency, must contact the Chlorine Free Products Association to request and sign an Authorization Agreement. {See Example page # 2}

2. The CFPA, or the manufacturer, must be able to provide a Certificate of Authenticity. We keep on file a signed affidavit by the CEO or President and Plant Manager verifying the certified manufacturers commitment to comply with the CFPA TCF/PCF Guidelines. The auditing consultant, and Executive Director of the CFPA for all products, or grades that have been certified also sign this document. A copy of this affidavit is available to anyone who requests a Certificate of Authenticity.

3. When printing the TCF mark either description should accompany: "THESE MARKS AND TERMS ARE REGISTERED TRADEMARKS OF THE CFPA."

Or

"This TCF certification mark and term are the sole property of the Chlorine Free Products Association and are only used by authorized and certified users."

4. To be printed using Pantone 2727 U for uncoated paper. To be printed using Pantone 2727 C for coated paper. May be printed Black.

**3. Assignment**

The Authorized Party shall not assign this agreement, in whole or in part, without the prior consent of the CFPA.

**4. Term**

This Agreement is in effect on the date of execution, and terminates one year from the date of signature.

**5. Termination**

If the Authorized Party fails to comply at any time with any of the authorization conditions identified in this agreement, the CFPA may terminate this agreement seven (7) days after notification of non-compliance.

**6. Applicable Law**

The laws of the United States of America govern this agreement

**7. Communications**

The parties agree to accept facsimile communications and email for the purposes of this Agreement.

**8. Execution**
